Selection Criteria

EYP Germany holds high academic standards for its sessions. The candidates will be evaluated and selected based on the following criteria.

- Excellent English language skills
- Academic ability to engage with a wide variety of current European issues
- Sense of responsibility, strong motivation and commitment to further the EYP's objectives
- Relevant EYP experience and a solid understanding of the EYP
- Excellent planning and organisational skills
- Excellent leadership skills and advanced understanding of group dynamics as well as ability to provide feedback
- Ability to work as a member of a team and with individuals from various cultural and socio-economic backgrounds
- Ability to facilitate and work together with different teams
- A strong personal vision for the Session and role and motivation to preside the particular session
- Ability to plan, run and evaluate training modules
- A sense awareness of one's own strengths and weaknesses in the role
- A positive record of pre-session and post-session reliability

EYP Germany would like to ensure the diversity of its sessions. Considering that half of each Chairs team will be German, presidential applications of candidates of non-German background will be favoured should they have the same qualification as a candidate with German background according to the above criteria. Should no candidates fulfil the above criteria, even after we prolong the call at least once, we reserve the right to invite candidates.

Questions for Applicants

- In case you are applying to more than one session, please state which sessions you could attend and in which order you would like to prioritise them.
- Please, explain how you fulfil the criteria for the role of the President and support your reasoning with concrete examples. (max 300 words)
 - Bear in mind the special challenge that the Chair's team will consist of 16 chairs and 2 Vice-Presidents who will also be chairing one of the nine committees each.
 - Please refer to the criteria mentioned in this document.
- Please, share with us your motivation to preside one of EYP Germany's regional sessions. (max 300 words)
- What is your vision for the inter-team cooperation during the session? (max 300 words)
