Dear applicant,

Thank you for your interest in applying to the regional sessions of EYP Germany. We are looking for **14 to 16 Chairpersons** and **9 Journalists for each session** and **two Editorial Assistants for the RSC in Kassel**. The Editorial Assistants for the RSC South have already been called.

If you are available for different sessions, it is also possible to apply to multiple sessions. In that case you can state your preferences in the application form.

The deadline for submitting your application is **Tuesday, the 29th of December 2020 at 23:59 (midnight) CET / Berlin time**. Please make sure to read the instructions on the next page.

Disclaimer: Due to the ongoing pandemic, EYP DE plans to let the delegates take part digitally. As for the officials, two scenarios are currently being prepared for: a) all officials participating in person or b) all organisers and the extended leadership meeting in person. Due to previous travel restrictions enforced by the German government, EYP DE has decided to ask all applicants for their residency, but will not make it a formal selection criteria.

Call Questions

Questions for Chairpersons

1. Reflecting back on your EYP journey, what was the most important thing you learned? (200-250 words)
2. What has motivated you to apply for this session as a chairperson? Please elaborate on your expectations in terms of personal development from this session and the role of the chairperson. (200-350 words)
3. Imagine you participated in the session as a chairperson and the session has come to an end. What would you want your delegates to be thinking? How are they feeling? Include an explanation of the atmosphere you hope to create as a chairperson. (200-250 words)
4. Tell us something you are most worried about regarding the session and explain why. (200-250 words)
5. Taking the COVID-situation into consideration, would you be willing to continue participating in the session, even if it does not take place in person?

Questions for Journalists

1. What would you consider are your strengths, and what would you like to improve upon working in the media team at the German Regionals this year? (250-350 words)
2. Think of one media project based on the session theme (200-250 words)
3. What does creativity mean to you? (100-200 words)
4. Share anything that you have created, and explain the what, why and how. (200-250 words)
5. Taking the COVID-situation into consideration, would you be willing to continue participating in the session, even if it does not take place in person?

Questions for Editorial Assistants (Kassel only)

1. How would your strengths contribute to the editorial team and what weaknesses would you like to improve upon at the RSC Kassel 2021?
2. How would you like to see EYP Media develop in the future and where would you, therefore, want to put your focus for the upcoming session?
3. Share a project that you have created and are excited about, and explain its purpose and development.
4. The theme of the Session is: “Technology that works for the people”. Share your interpretation of this and how it would translate into the work of the Media Team.
5. Taking the COVID situation into consideration, would you be willing to continue participating in the session, even if it does not take place in person?



How to apply

If you are available and interested in applying, you should follow these steps to apply:

Log on to the EYP Member Platform (if you do not have access or encounter any other problems with the platform, please, get in touch with support@eyp.org).

Update your personal profile on the platform. Please, make sure your full name, country, home National Committee, session history and contact information are available and updated.

If you want to apply as a **Chairperson or Journalist**, go to the **event's page on the Member Platform of each session you want to apply to**. On the event's page, you will be asked to fill in a **google form** which is the actual application form. In case you are applying to multiple sessions, **you only need to fill in the google form ONCE**. However, you still need to go to all events' pages of the sessions you would like to attend and click the box "I understand and I filled in the google form".

If you want to apply as an **Editorial Assistant for Kassel**, please fill in the **questions on the Members' Platform**.

Why so complicated?

As we are calling for two sessions at the same time, a lot of people are involved in the selection process (3 HOs, 2 Presidents, 2 Editors as well as board members of EYP Germany). Using a Google form helps us to keep an overview. However, the selection panel still needs access to your evaluations which is why you have to fill in the form on the Member Platform additionally.
